Elewana Arusha Coffee Lodge

2 Night | January 15–17, 2027

Arusha Coffee Lodge is hidden among one of Tanzania's largest coffee plantations and beautifully positioned below the rugged peak of Mount Meru. The homey feel of the lodge is by no means accidental as the origins of the homestead continue to emit glimpses of times-gone-by. The main Plantation House is home to an à la carte restaurant, an intimate bar, and a cozy lounge, all of which have inviting open log fires. There are two boutiques, an enclosed swimming pool, and a popular garden terrace. The main lodge areas offer complimentary Wi-Fi.

Plantation Rooms are beautifully designed and adorned with comfortable furnishings. Each room features an en-suite bathroom including a triple-headed shower, bathrobes and slippers, hairdryer, electronic safe, mini-bar, telephone, tea and coffee making facilities, and a veranda overlooking the surrounding coffee garden.

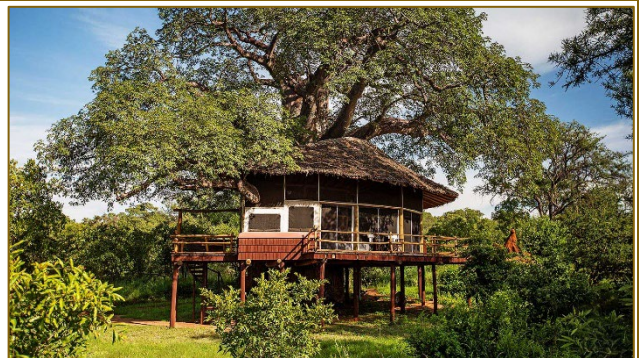


Elewana Tarangire Treetops

2 Nights | January 17–19, 2027

Tarangire Treetops sits on the border of Tarangire National Park. You are welcomed with a blaze of color and a host of smiles by the local Maasai tribesmen. The enchanting main lodge encases a thousand-year-old baobab tree. Dining at Treetops offers truly memorable moments with a lantern-lit dinner in a traditional Boma. Treetop Rooms are some of the largest bedrooms to be found in any camp or lodge in East Africa at 700 sq. ft., including an exotic double shower en-suite bathroom.
